Home Maintenance 101

For women 18 and older: This hands-on, interactive class is designed to teach you how to perform basic home maintenance and improvements. Students will receive a better understanding of how their home works, how to troubleshoot problems and learn to do routine maintenance to their homes. Topics and activities will include but are not limited to, learning which tools, and products, are needed for basic home maintenance (and how to use them). How to perform routine maintenance and improvements such as: locating shut-off valves, patching holes in walls and ceilings, properly preparing and painting walls and moldings, repair leaky faucets, repair a running toilet, securely hang just about anything on a wall, installing and inspecting smoke detectors, replacing furnace filters, replacing light fixtures, and installing dimmer switches.
